#### Direct Debit Guarantee

The guarantee should be detached and retained by the payee. This guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that take part in the Direct Debit Scheme. The efficiency and security of the scheme is monitored by your own Bank or Building Society. If the amount to be paid or the payment dates change, the CPSA will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed.

If an error is made by the CPSA or your Bank or Building Society you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your Branch of the amount paid.

You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your Bank or Building Society. Please also send a copy of your letter to the CPSA.

### Protection of your Shotgun Certificate and Legal Expenses *(For Full members only)*

In the event of a shotgun certificate being revoked or not renewed.

There have been some concerns over firearms licencing decision making, resulting in revocation of or refusal to renew shotgun certificates. Some police forces leave it to the courts to decide, but it is expensive for certificate holders to challenge this decision. By providing enhanced cover we can support members who have been treated unreasonably and help them continue to enjoy their sport.

Since its introduction in April 2014, the CPSA has supported a number of claims on behalf of members. The authorities appear to be tightening up on certification and it could be something as trivial as an argument with a neighbour that sparks interest in your suitability to own a gun.

Being covered for this type of claim will also help us to stand together to defend the legal rights of responsible shotgun owners without the worry of the potential costs for the individual.
